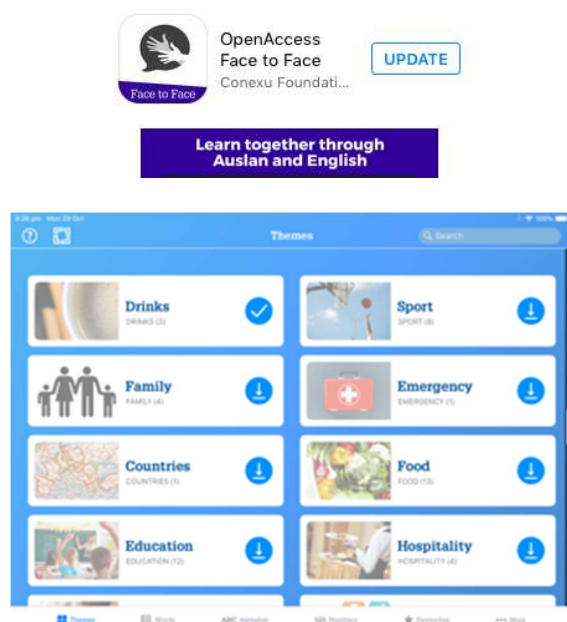


Step by step guide: OpenAccess Face to Face

How to make the best use of the App

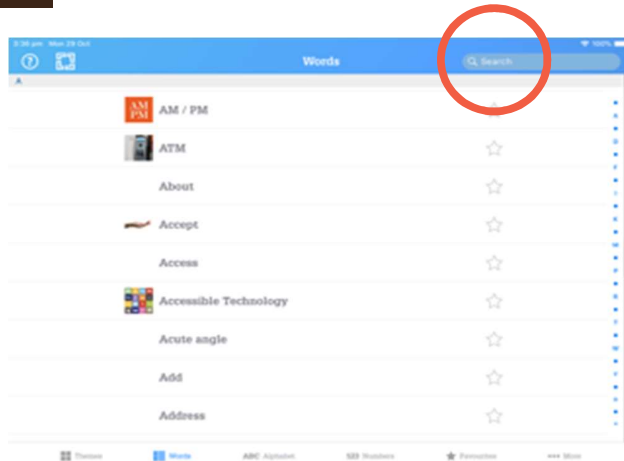
1 Download the app ✓



Download the app and its content for free on a Wi-Fi connection (available on iPad only).

- Open the App store on your iPad or iPhone, search for “OpenAccess Face to Face” and download.
- When you open the app, you will find a list of several themes including ‘Food’, ‘Family’, ‘Education’, ‘Everyday Words’, ‘Countries’, ‘Workplace’, ‘Sport’, etc.
- You can either chose which themes you want to download or download all themes.

2 Word or Phrase Search ✓



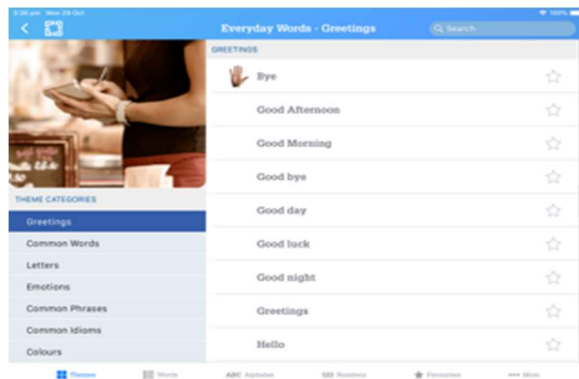
From the Words or Phrase Search page, search commonly used words by scrolling through the gallery, or typing the English word in the search bar.

The Word / Phrase search list is in A – Z order and there are over 2000 words or phrases.

Searching a word or phrase saves time.

If you use these words or phrases often, save them to 'Favourites' – learn about this in another section.

3 THEMES > Categories ✓



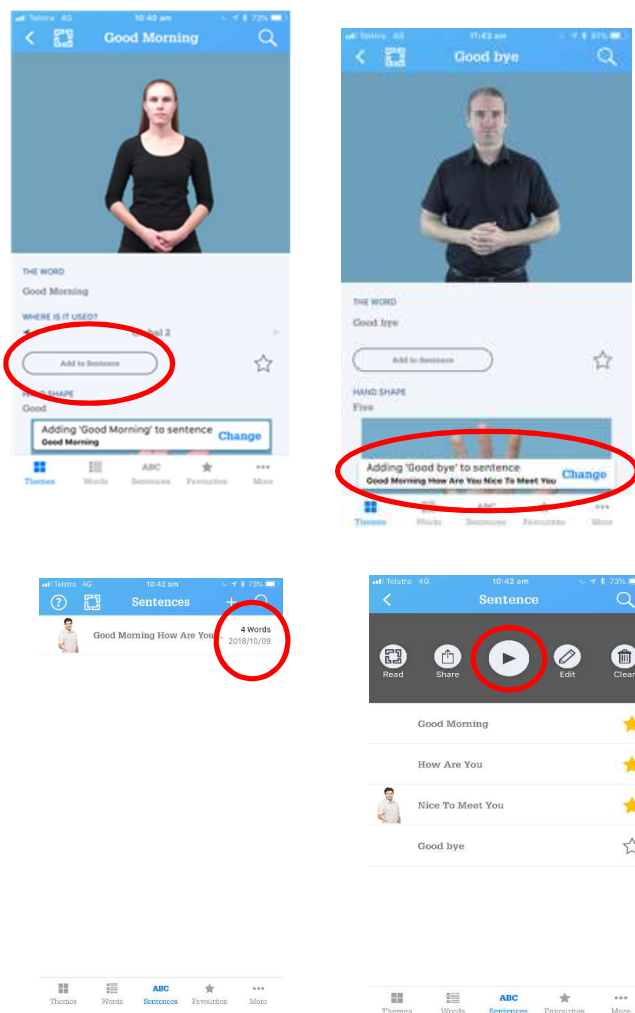
By tapping on the **THEMES** menu ITEM, you can access the **CATEGORIES** menu. Some Themes have many words or phrases so we had to divide them into categories. Here's an example:

- Theme "Everyday words"
 - "Categories"
 - Greetings
 - Common words
 - Letters
 - **And more**

If you are holding your iPad landscape, you'll see these already on the bottom of the screen left hand side.

Sentence creation ✓



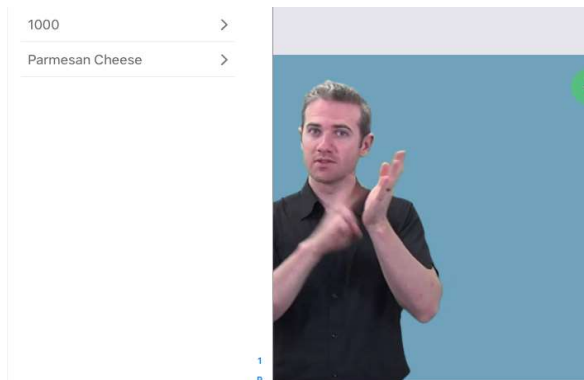
Here's how you can create a sentence:

- Select a word or phrase
- When you select 'Add a sentence', the word or phrase is listed.
- To add more words / phrase, go back to the word list by selecting the 'back arrow' on top left hand corner. Then select another word / phrase and select 'Add a sentence'. You can keep doing this and add as many words or phrase as you
- When you select 'Sentence' at the bottom of the screen, you will see the sentence listed. See below
- When you select the sentence, it will show you all the words you have picked.
- You can press the 'play' button to see the sentence in sequence.

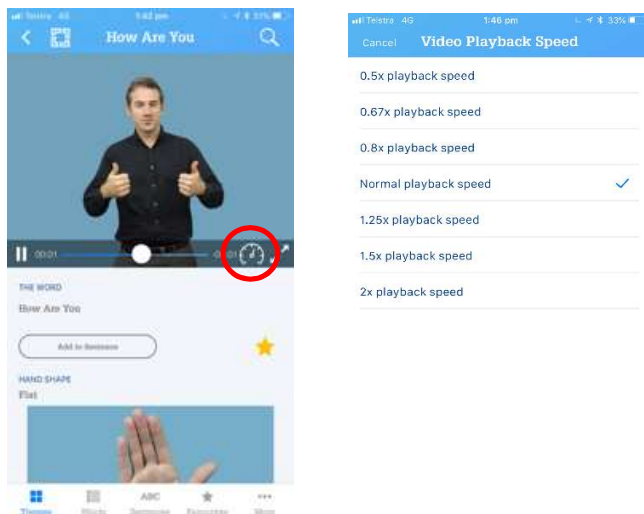
5 Favourites ✓



You can save your favourite words to refer back to.

- Select a word, phrase from any list.
- Tap the star on the right side of the word to save into the Favourites folder

6 Other Features ✓

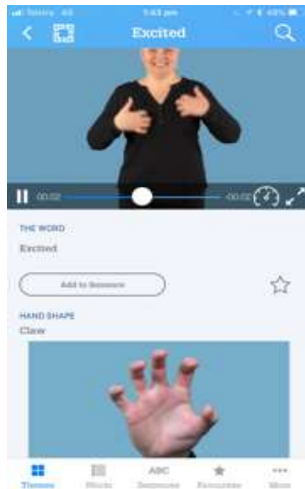


You can slow the **video speed** down to help with accuracy and checking how to use the right handshape.

When you play an Auslan video of and word or phrase, you will see a 'speedo' symbol on the screen.

Select the 'speedo' and you can adjust the speed to make it faster or slower. Pretty cool!

7 Handshapes ✓

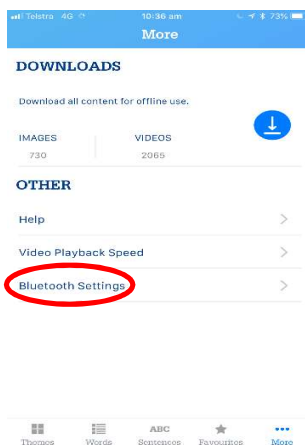


You can find handshapes photos for individual words to help you make the correct sign.

Did you know that Auslan has 62 key handshapes that are commonly used and some are used more often than others. A handshape could be a 'pointing finger', a 'flat hand', a 'fist', etc.

In this picture, you can see the sign 'excited' and the handshape called the 'claw'.

8 Pairing Devices ✓



To share Auslan learning with another person you can pair your iPad or iPhone with another iPad or iPhone.

This assists shared learning and practicing finding words, Auslan signs and phrases.

Select 'More' from home screen at bottom right corner. Then select 'Bluetooth settings'.
